



MXI Compliance Statement to Section 508 of the US Rehabilitation Act

MXI Security, a division of Memory Experts International, is committed to ensure that its products remain accessible to everyone, particularly people with disabilities. The technologies administered to build our products are based on and compliant with the Section 508 standards. MXI Security regularly reviews its products for Section 508 compliance. Electronic and Information Technology products manufactured by MXI Security are governed by Sections 1194.25 for self-contained, closed products or Section 1194.21 for the embedded user-interface software application.

Self-contained, closed products manufactured by MXI Security, comply with Section 1194.25 of Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act. Specifically, the Stealth MXP family of products, which includes the Stealth MXP and Stealth MXP Passport, that use biometric forms of user identification or control include use of a password as an alternative form of identification or activation which does not require the user to possess particular biological characteristics.

The embedded user-interface software application, called ACCESS, loaded on the Stealth MXP family of products, including the Stealth MXP and Stealth MXP Passport, complies with Section 1194.21 of Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act. For example, software execution is accomplished via keyboard for password entry, does not disrupt or is able activated features or other products identified as accessibility features, and provides a well-defined on-screen indication of the current focus so that assistive technology can track focus and focus change.
